

# CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Measurements include  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances. Patterns for appliqué pieces and full-size placement are on page 7. Follow manufacturer's instructions for using fusible web. Border strips are exact length needed. You may want to cut them longer to allow for piecing variations.

## FROM ASSORTED DARK BLUE BATIK 3/8-YARD PIECES, CUT A TOTAL OF:

- 3 ( $4\frac{1}{4}$ "-wide) strips. From strips, cut 22 ( $4\frac{1}{4}$ ") squares. Cut squares in half diagonally in both directions to make 88 quarter-square K triangles.
- 4 (3"-wide) strips. From strips, cut 48 (3") A squares.
- 6 ( $2\frac{3}{8}$ "-wide) strips. From strips, cut 96 ( $2\frac{3}{8}$ ") G squares.
- 5 (2"-wide) strips. From strips, cut 48 ( $2" \times 3\frac{1}{2}"$ ) F rectangles.
- 20 ( $1\frac{1}{2}$ "-wide) strips. From strips, cut 48 ( $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 5"$ ) E rectangles, 96 ( $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 4"$ ) D rectangles, and 48 ( $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 3"$ ) C rectangles.
- 152 Petals.
- 92 Circles.

## FROM DARK BLUE BATIK, CUT:

- 8 ( $5\frac{1}{2}$ "-wide) strips. Piece strips to make 2 ( $5\frac{1}{2}" \times 75\frac{1}{2}"$ ) side outer borders and 2 ( $5\frac{1}{2}" \times 68\frac{1}{2}"$ ) top and bottom outer borders.
- 7 ( $2\frac{1}{2}$ "-wide) strips. Piece strips to make 2 ( $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 68\frac{1}{2}"$ ) side inner borders and 2 ( $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 55\frac{1}{2}"$ ) top and bottom inner borders.
- 9 ( $1\frac{1}{2}$ "-wide) strips for binding. NOTE: If not making binding with faux piping, cut 9 ( $2\frac{1}{4}$ "-wide) strips for binding.

## FROM MEDIUM BLUE BATIK, CUT:

- 2 ( $3\frac{1}{2}$ "-wide) strips. From strips, cut 12 ( $3\frac{1}{2}"$ ) I squares.

## FROM LIGHT BLUE BATIK, CUT:

- 2 ( $18\frac{1}{4}$ "-wide) strips. From strips, cut 3 ( $18\frac{1}{4}"$ ) squares and 2 ( $9\frac{3}{8}"$ ) squares. Cut  $18\frac{1}{4}"$  squares in half diagonally in both directions to make 12 side setting triangles (2 are extra). Cut  $9\frac{3}{8}"$  squares in half diagonally to make 4 corner setting triangles.
- 2 ( $12\frac{1}{2}$ "-wide) strips. From strips, cut 6 ( $12\frac{1}{2}"$ ) J squares.
- 9 ( $1\frac{3}{4}$ "-wide) strips for binding accent (piping).

## FROM ASSORTED LIGHT BLUE BATIK FAT QUARTERS, CUT A TOTAL OF:

- 6 ( $4\frac{1}{4}$ "-wide) strips. From strips, cut 22 ( $4\frac{1}{4}"$ ) squares. Cut squares in half diagonally in both directions to make 88 quarter-square K triangles. **NOTE:** For variety, the designer substituted a few cream K triangles.

## FROM CREAM BATIK, CUT:

- 3 ( $4\frac{1}{4}$ "-wide) strips. From strips, cut 24 ( $4\frac{1}{4}"$ ) H squares. NOTE: For variety, the designer substituted a few light blue H squares.
- 9 ( $2\frac{1}{2}$ "-wide) strips. From strips, cut 144 ( $2\frac{1}{2}"$ ) B squares. **NOTE:** For variety, the designer substituted a few light blue B squares.
