The more you make, the better your chances! We will draw a name for every 20(ish) blocks, so there will be more than one winner (but you may win only once).

If you want to make this improv quilt, regardless, make doubles and keep a set for yourself. More work, but you'll be assured as many blocks as you contribute. If you win, you'll have those plus several more!
